## The Plight of the Girls in Nepal

Often I remember the story of the five year old Kabita. Her mother was dead, and her father had disappeared. She lived on the street with her grandmother. Tables of the teashops were where they slept, since the income from selling herbs did not cover the rent.

Such encounters were frequent during my fifteen years stay in Nepal as unemployment and poverty are everyday. Families break up and children are neglected. Girls, especially have a low status in society and therefore receive less or worse food and less attention than boys. Most believe, it is not worth investing in a girl's education as they will leave the family once they marry. Girl like Kabita are given a new home at Kiran Kinderhouse in Kathmandu as well as education and better future.

## A unified Family

In November 1998, the Kiran Kinderhouse in Nepal first opened their doors in six full and half orphans. In the meantime (in 2012), the number of residents has more than quadruplicated.

In their new home the girls live together like a big family in which they are individually watched and cared for. As a result, they learn how to live their lives without their parents and how they can develop in a free and safe way.

For many of the young residents the move into the new home also means a step into a new life. They knew neither beds nor underwear and they had first learn to eat with spoon and use toilet.

Thanks to good medical support, good education and later job training the girls have now a chance to lead a successful life.
